The Medicaid Nursing Home Program has revised providers' reimbursement rates effective December 1, 2009. These changes are cost neutral.

Specifically, the changes are as follows:

- Medicaid payments in the Administrative & Routine, Other Patient Care, and Capital cost centers will be reduced by 7.796 percent instead of the previous 8.681 percent;
- Reimbursement for the nursing portion of a Light Care day will be reduced by 3 percent; and
- Reimbursement for Hospital Leave bed reservations will be decreased by 50 percent.

The Department is proposing to amend COMAR 10.09.10.07, .11 and .16 to reflect these actions.
