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## MDH Office of Pharmacy Services Call Center Helpline Changes to Voicemail System

Due to the state of emergency as a result of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus pandemic (*COVID-19*), effective 4/24/20, the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) Office of Pharmacy Services Fee-for-Service Medicaid Helpline will be transitioning to a voicemail system. When callers dial 1-800-492-5231, option # 3, they will be instructed to leave a voicemail with their name, Medicaid ID number or Provider number, and contact information, and MDH staff will return their calls as soon as possible during normal business hours. The voicemail option will be available Monday through Friday from 8 AM to 5 PM. We are expecting to see higher volumes of inquiries due to this change. Please be patient as calls will be returned within 1 business day.
