Testing for COVID-19 by Medicaid Pharmacies - Follow-up Guidance

On May 28, 2020, the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) released guidance on Testing for COVID-19 by Medicaid Pharmacies (see <u>COVID-19 - #18 – Testing for COVID-19 by Medicaid</u> <u>Pharmacies</u> and <u>ADVISORY No. 212</u>)

As our partners respond with clarifying questions to this temporary guidance, the Medicaid Feefor-Service (FFS) Pharmacy Program is releasing this document to provide further information.

Pharmacies may bill for specimen collection service for COVID-19 testing using one of the following two NDC Codes:

- 11877001126
- 22066000511

NDC 11877001127 is no longer an allowable NDC to use for specimen collection.
