Testing for COVID-19 by Medicaid Pharmacies - Follow-up Guidance (UPDATED)

On May 28, 2020, the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) released guidance on Testing for COVID-19 by Medicaid Pharmacies (see COVID-19 by Medicaid Pharmacies, ADVISORY No. 212 and ADVISORY No. 213)

As our partners respond with clarifying questions to this guidance, the Medicaid Fee-for-Service (FFS) Pharmacy Program is releasing this document to provide further information.

Pharmacies may bill for specimen collection service for COVID-19 testing using one of the following four NDC Codes:
