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Updated Pharmacy Provider Guidance on Professional Dispensing Fees

As a result of a recent Cost of Dispensing Survey, the Office of Pharmacy Services (OPS) has made modifications to the current Fee-for-Service (FFS) reimbursement, related to the Professional Dispensing fees. Effective 2/1/2021, there will be an increase in the Professional Dispensing fees paid to Maryland Medicaid FFS community participating pharmacy providers for covered services. This includes covered services rendered to participants in nursing facilities.

The following modifications have been made to the Maryland Medicaid FFS Professional Dispensing fees:

- Professional Dispensing fee to non-LTC (Long-Term Care)/NH (Nursing Home) Pharmacies increased from \$10.49 to \$10.67.
- Professional Dispensing fee to LTC/NH Pharmacies increased from \$11.49 to \$11.67.
