Transition of Coverage for Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition Supplements from the Pharmacy Program to the Disposable Medical Supplies/Durable Medical Equipment (DMS/DME) Program

Effective February 1, 2021, the Office of Pharmacy Services (OPS) has made a Pharmacy benefit change regarding Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition (PEN) products for the Fee-for-Service (FFS) Program. All PEN products will now be covered by the Maryland Disposable Medical Supplies/ Durable Medical Equipment Program (DMS/DME), Division of Community Support Services.

Claims for PEN products submitted through the Pharmacy Point-of-Sale (POS) system, will reject and request submission to the DME Program.
