Update of Nutritional Prior Authorization (DHMH 3495) Form

Maryland Medicaid Fee-For-Service (FFS), Office of Pharmacy Services has updated Prior Authorization (PA) form DHMH 3495 (formerly known as the Nutritional Supplement PA form) due to the changes announced in <u>Advisory 223</u>. The new name for the updated PA form is "Revised Prescriber Statement of Medical Necessity Oral Supplements and Vitamin Pre-authorization Form".
