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## **Pharmacists Professional Services (Updated)**

In accordance with <u>Senate Bill 678/House Bill 1151</u>, the Maryland Department of Health will allow Medicaid enrolled pharmacist providers to bill Maryland Medicaid for professional services rendered within their lawful scope of practice.

**Effective January 1, 2024**, Pharmacists, who meet all Medicaid and Board of Pharmacy (Board) requirements as described in the Health Occupations Article 12 of the Pharmacy Act can be reimbursed for services listed on the <a href="mailto:transmittal#PT 29-24">transmittal#PT 29-24</a> and <a href="mailto:transmittal#PT 49-24">transmittal#PT 49-24</a>.
