**Subject:** Hospice Payment Rates for Federal Fiscal Year 2024

**Note:** Please ensure that appropriate staff members in your organization are informed of the contents of this transmittal.

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Attached are the Maryland Medicaid Program's hospice payment rates for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2023 (October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024). These rates are calculated based on the annual hospice rates established under Medicare and are authorized by Section 1814(i)(1)(C)(ii) of the Social Security Act.

Section 3004 of the Affordable Care Act established a quality reporting program for hospice providers. Section 1814(i)(5)(A)(i) of the Social Security Act requires that the Secretary shall reduce the market basket update by two percentage points for any hospice provider that does not comply with the quality data submission requirements. Any provider for whom the market basket reduction applies will receive their rates separately.

The hospice cap runs from October 1st of each year ending September 30th of the following year. The latest hospice cap amount for the year ending September 30, 2024 is \$33,494.01.
