Background



Bowie State University is the first historically black institution of higher education in Maryland established in 1865.

- #1 for value among Maryland's four-year colleges and universities (The Economist)
- 80% of BSU graduates remain in Maryland and contribute to the state's economic prosperity
- A top 5 university in Maryland for graduating African Americans with bachelor's degrees in nursing, biology and computer/information sciences (Diverse: Issues in Higher Education)
- Bowie State is home to a patent for a silent wind turbine design, developed by a physics
 professor and a student, which can operate with low wind speeds and is small enough to
 power a single home.
- The Bowie Business Innovation Center is located on the campus



Facilities and Specialized Equipment

Biology/Chemistry Laboratories

- The state-of-the-art Center for Natural Sciences, Mathematics and Nursing includes 23 new research labs.
- Equipment for biotechnology, bioinformatics, molecular biology, synthesis and characterization of new compounds.

Nursing Simulation Lab

 Premier simulation lab designed to flexibly change as educational strategies emerge.

Virtual Reality Laboratory

 Applies cutting-edge VR technology including augmented reality and software engineering. In addition, the lab allows robotics experimentation and research in Multi-agent systems for evacuation.

Cybersecurity and Information Assurance Laboratory

• *Provides* students with state-of-the-art technology equipment and software to attack and defend target computer networks in a secure environment.
