ORDER OF MODIFICATION

The Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the “Board”) is in receipt of a petition from Ketankumar Patel, License No. 10301, requesting modification of a certain term of probation as set forth in the Board’s Consent Order of Reinstatement, dated July 16, 2019. The Consent Order of Reinstatement placed Mr. Patel’s license on probation for a period of five (5) years based on a prior 2010 felony conviction. Specifically, Mr. Patel requests modification of his probationary conditions to allow him to practice in a dispensing role. Upon consideration of Mr. Patel’s petition, the Board voted to lift the prohibition against practicing in a dispensing role, as ordered below.

ORDER

It is this 22nd day of May, 2020, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, hereby,

ORDERED that Consent Order of Reinstatement, dated July 16, 2019, be modified to remove the condition that Mr. Patel only practice in a non-dispensing role for the first year of probation; and be it further,

ORDERED that Mr. Patel may practice pharmacy in a dispensing role in accordance with the Maryland Pharmacy Act; and be it further,

ORDERED that all other terms and conditions of the July 16, 2019, Consent Order of Reinstatement shall remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, General Provisions Article, Section 4-333.
