ELIGIBILITY CHECKLIST

- Under the age of 19 years
- Blood lead levels of 5 micrograms per deciliter ($\mu\text{g}/\text{dL}$) or more
- Eligible for or enrolled in Medicaid or Maryland Children's Health Insurance Program (MCHP)
- Visit (for 10 more hours per week) or live in the home/ apartment with a lead problem

QUICK-CHECK ELIGIBILITY LIST

- Under the age of 19 years
- Blood lead level of 5 micrograms per deciliter ($\mu\text{g}/\text{dL}$) or more
- Eligible for or enrolled in Medicaid or Maryland Children's Health Insurance Program (MCHIP)
- Live in or visit the home or apartment with a lead problem for 10 or more hours per week
