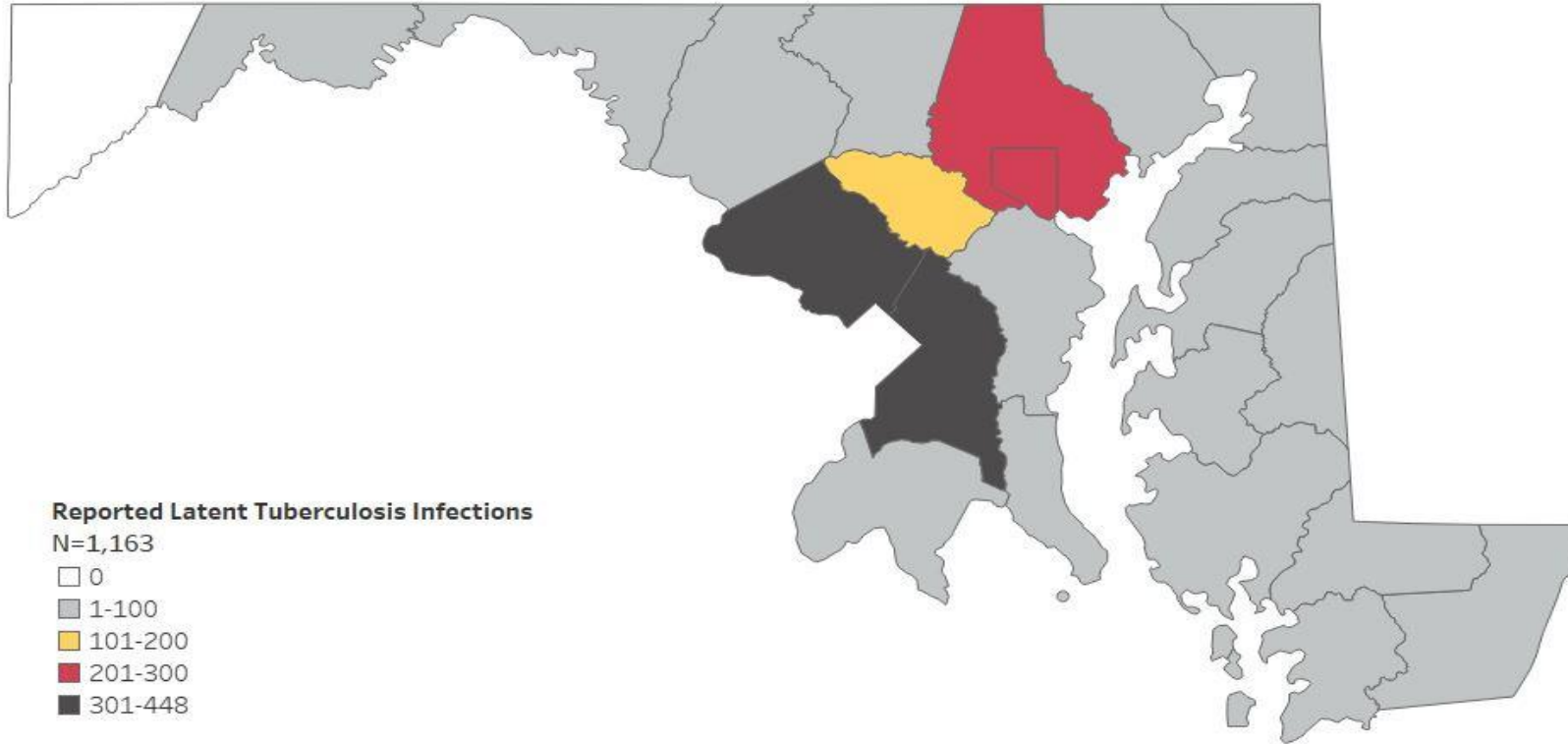
VISION

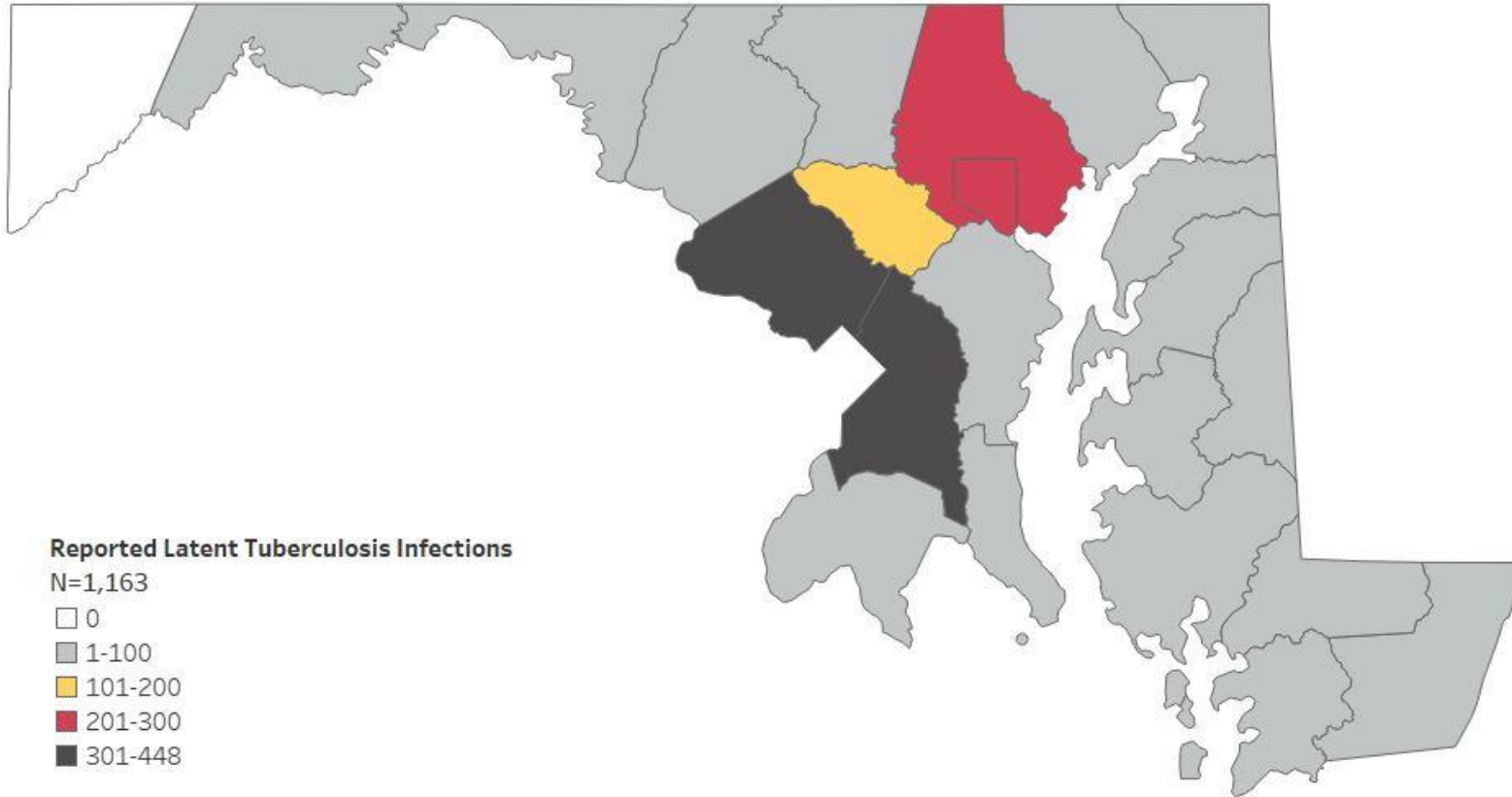
LTBI Cases in Maryland



Percent of cases reported:

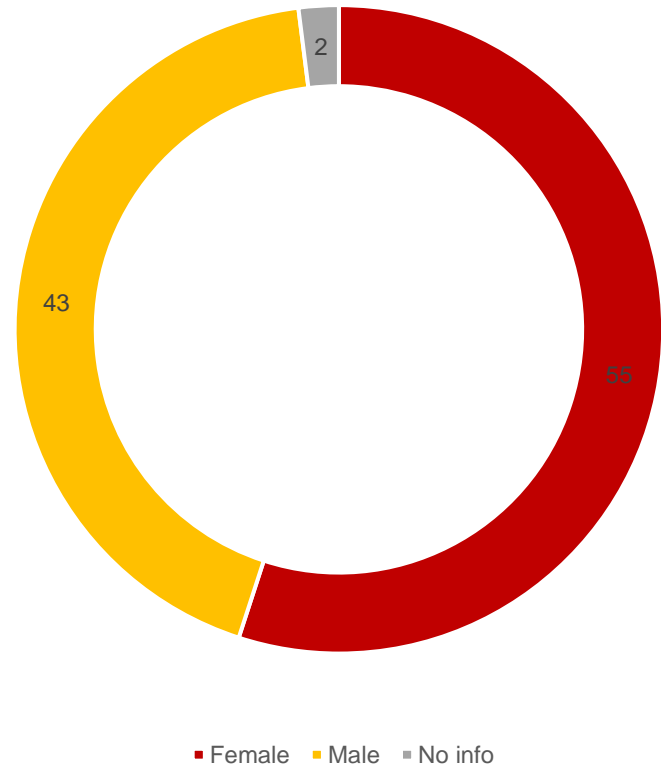
- Montgomery County (27%)

LTBI Cases in Maryland

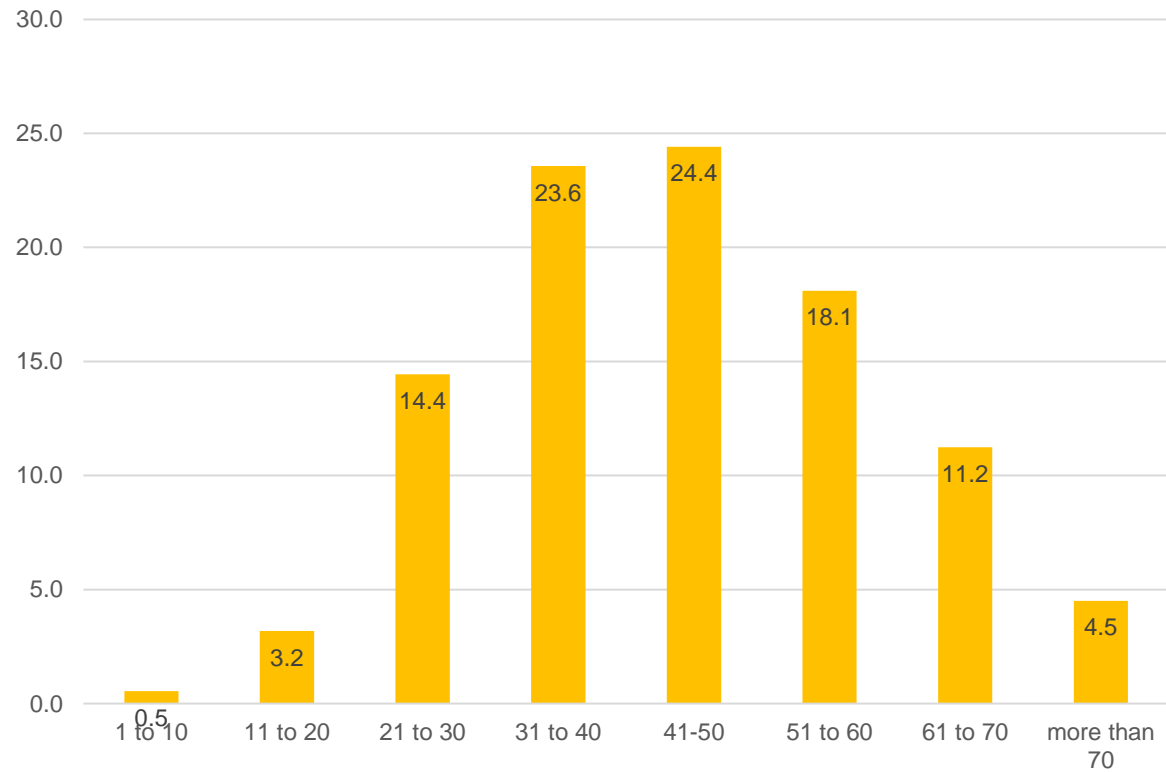

- Harford, Carroll, Charles, St. Marys, Cecil, Wicomico, Washington County (less than 2%)

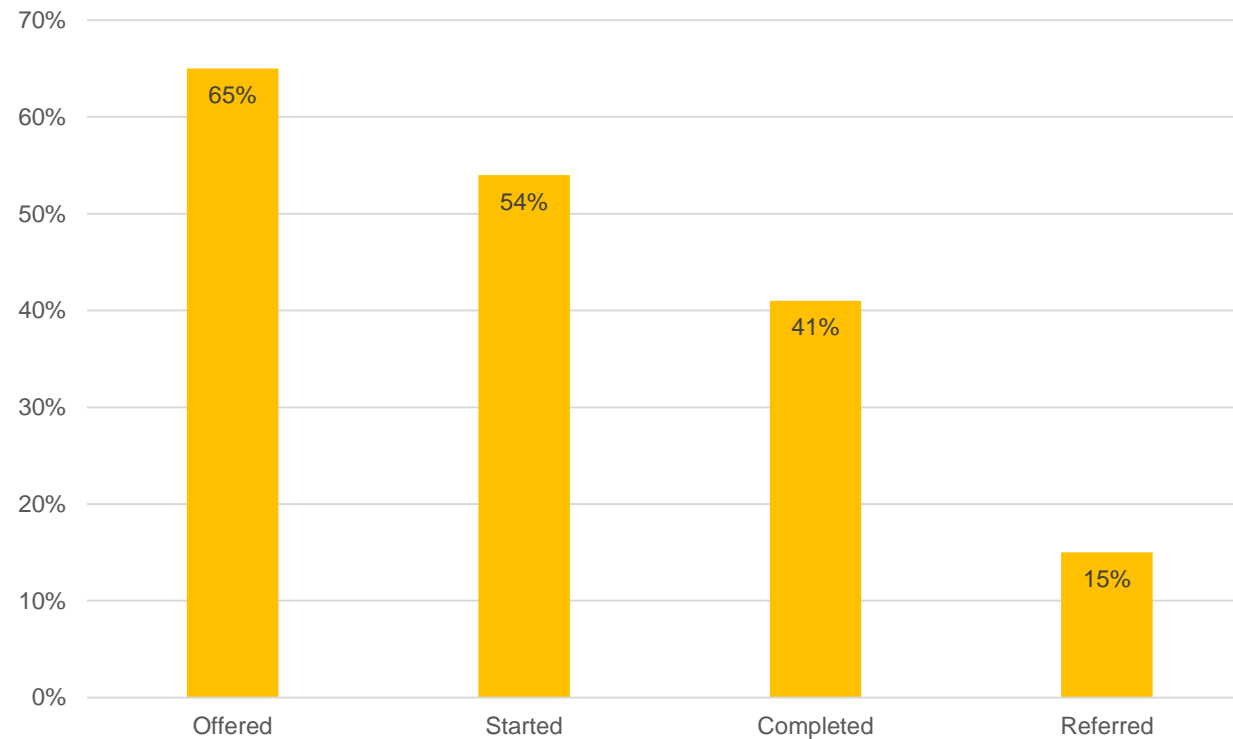
LTBI Current Sex Distribution



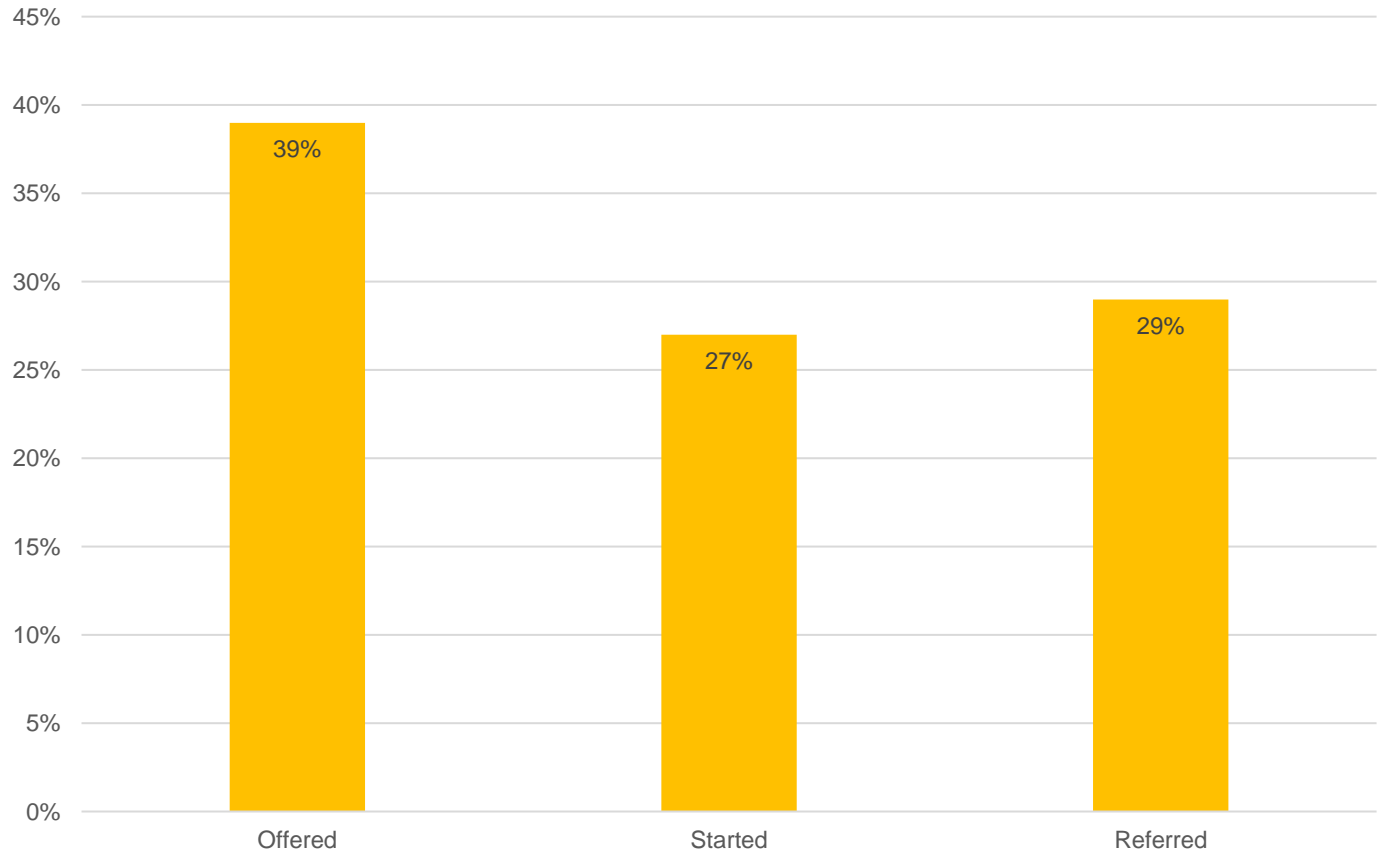
LTBI Age Distribution



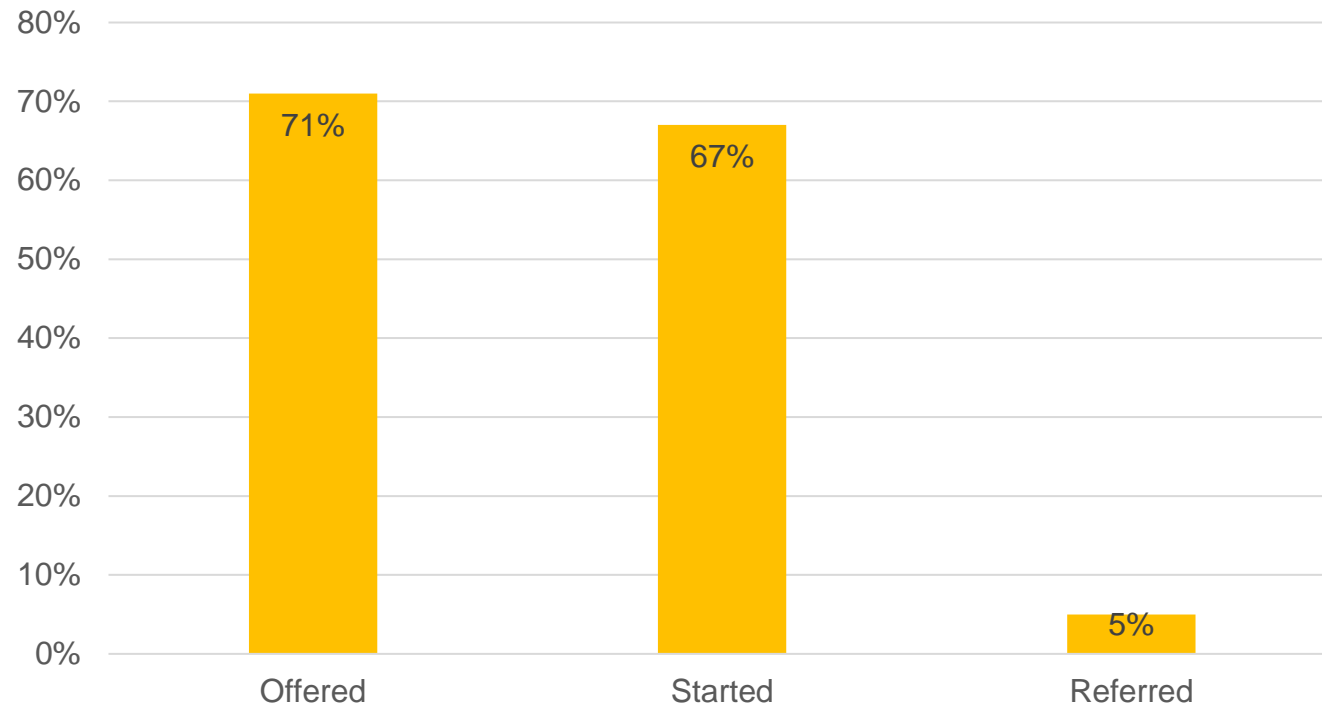
Local Health Department Confirmed LTBI Cases Treatment Status (2019)



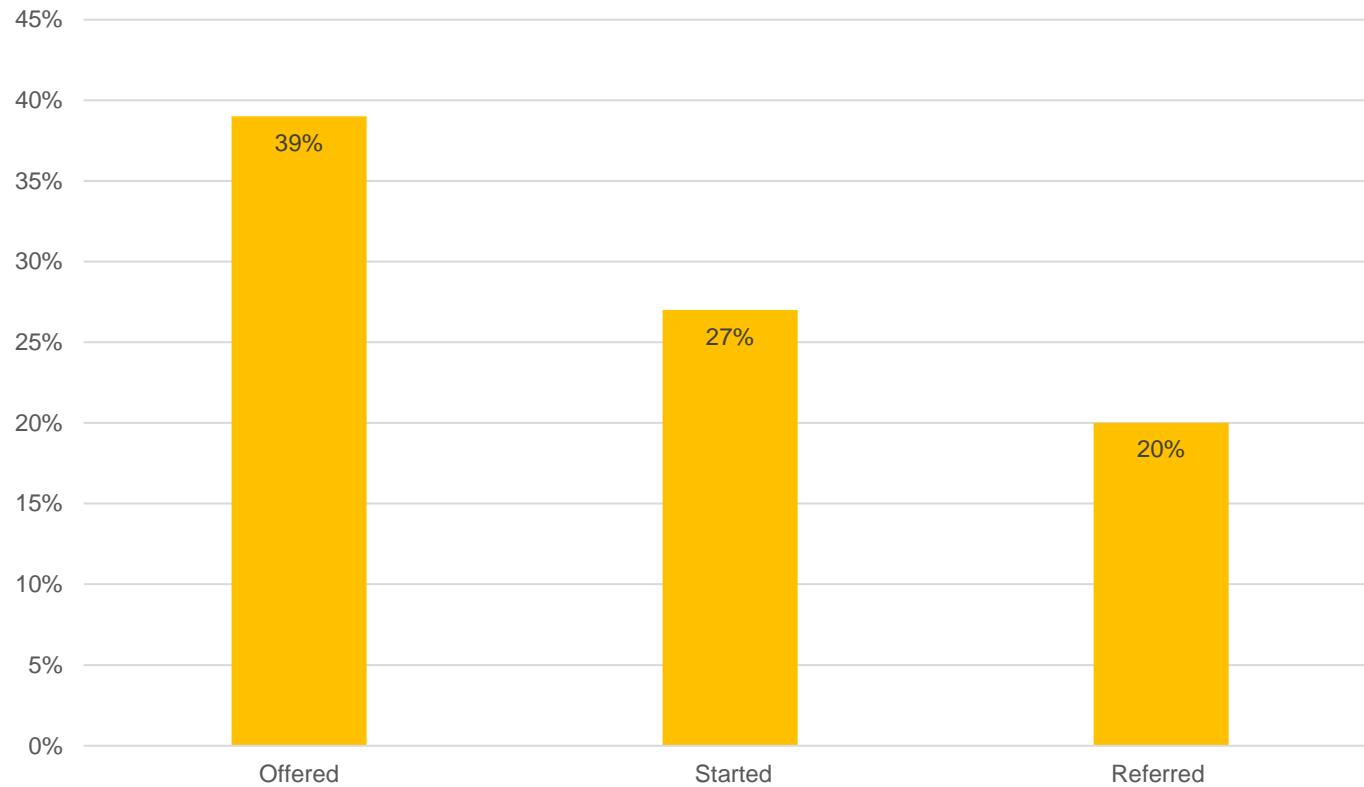
All Other Reporters Confirmed LTBI Cases Treatment Status (2019)
