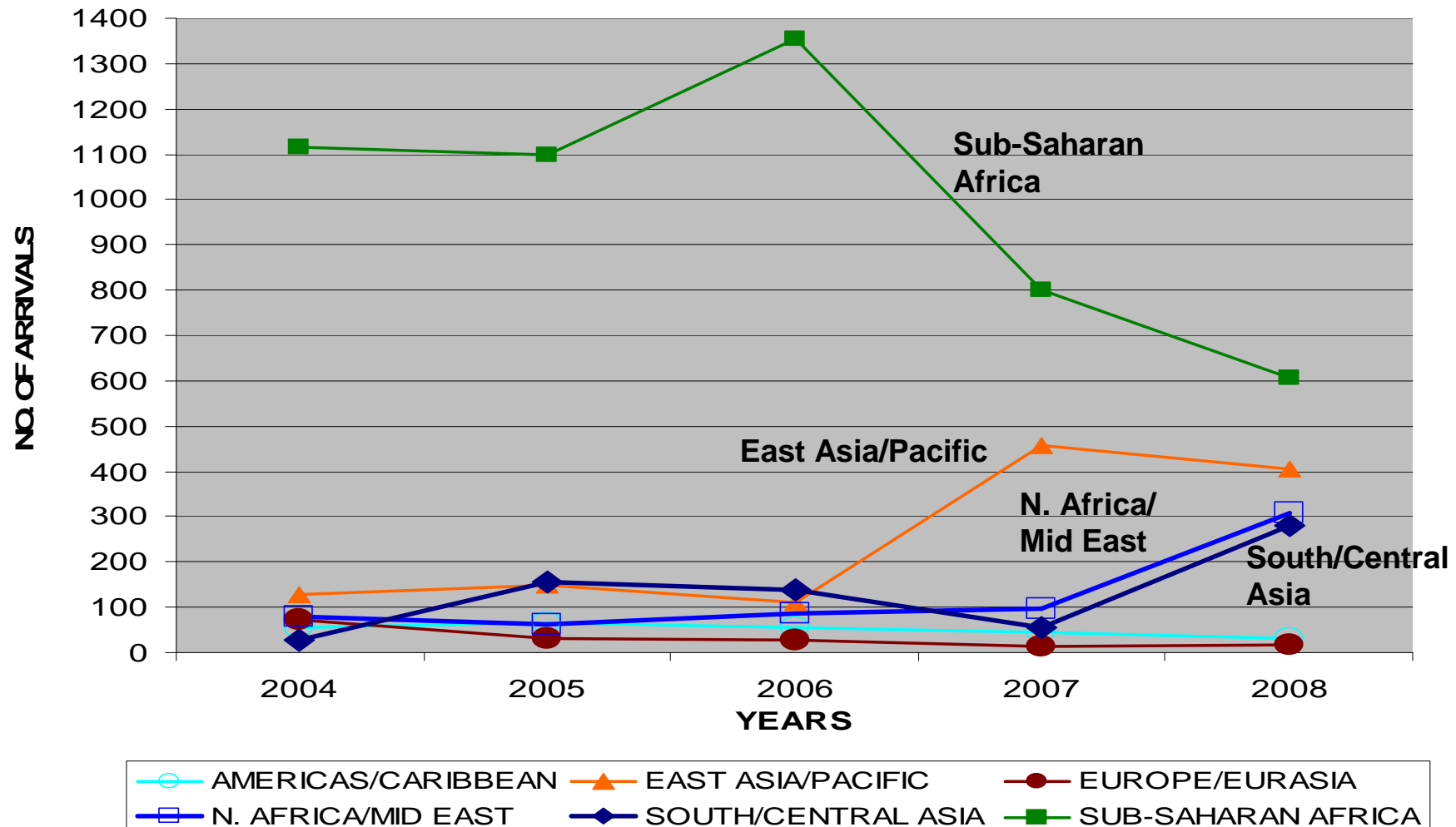
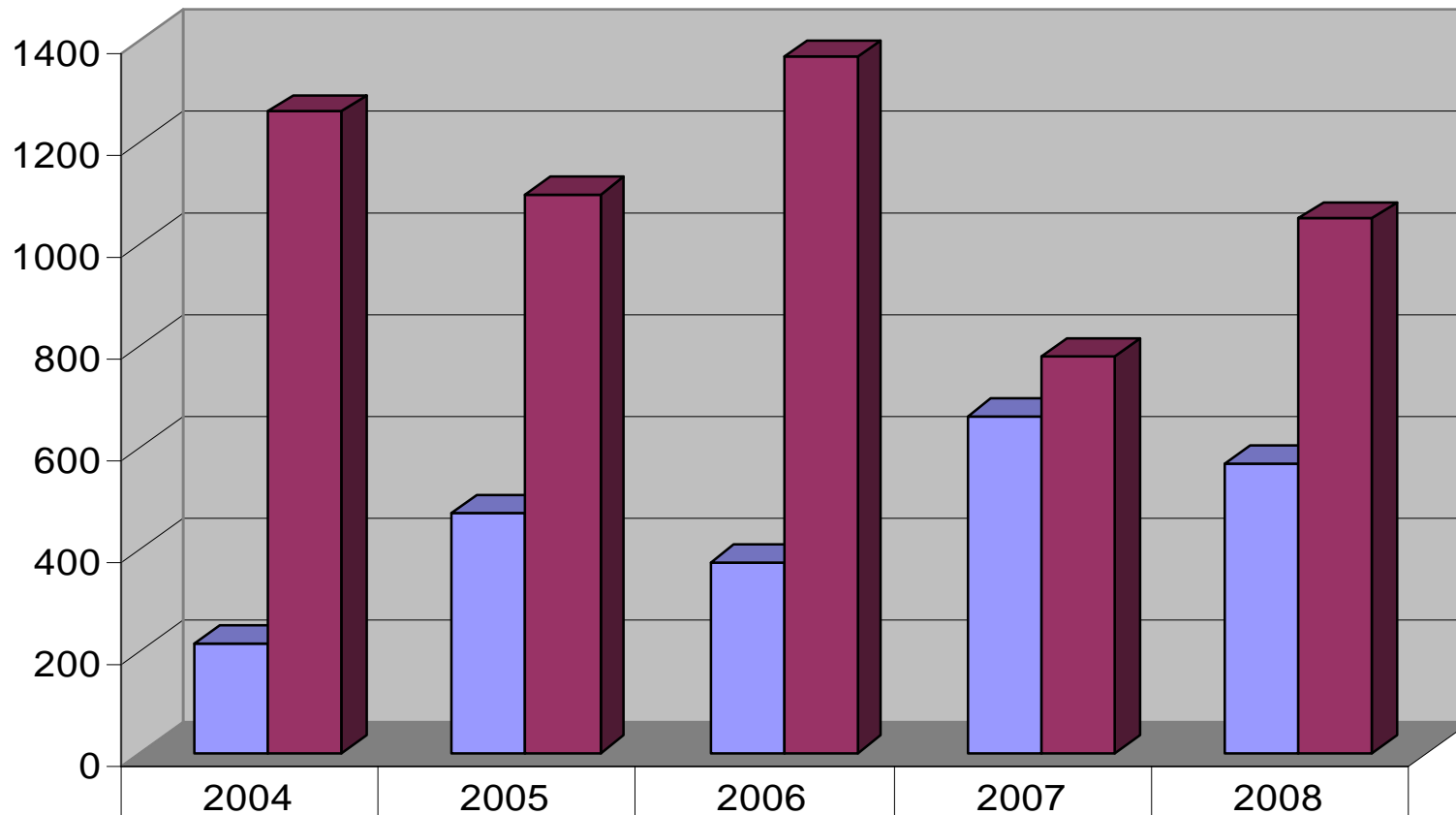

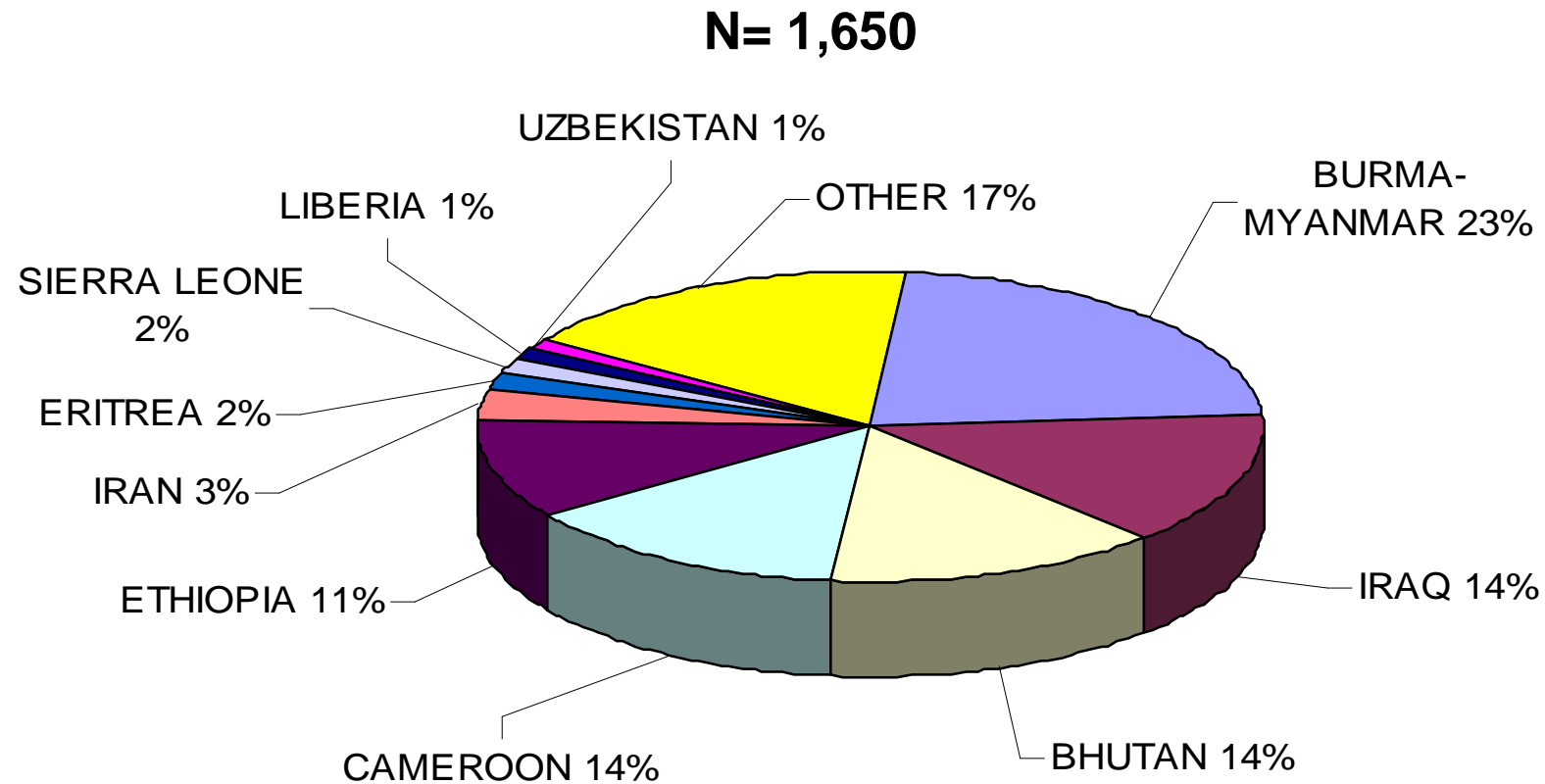


# Refugee vs. Asylee Arrivals in Maryland, 2004-2008

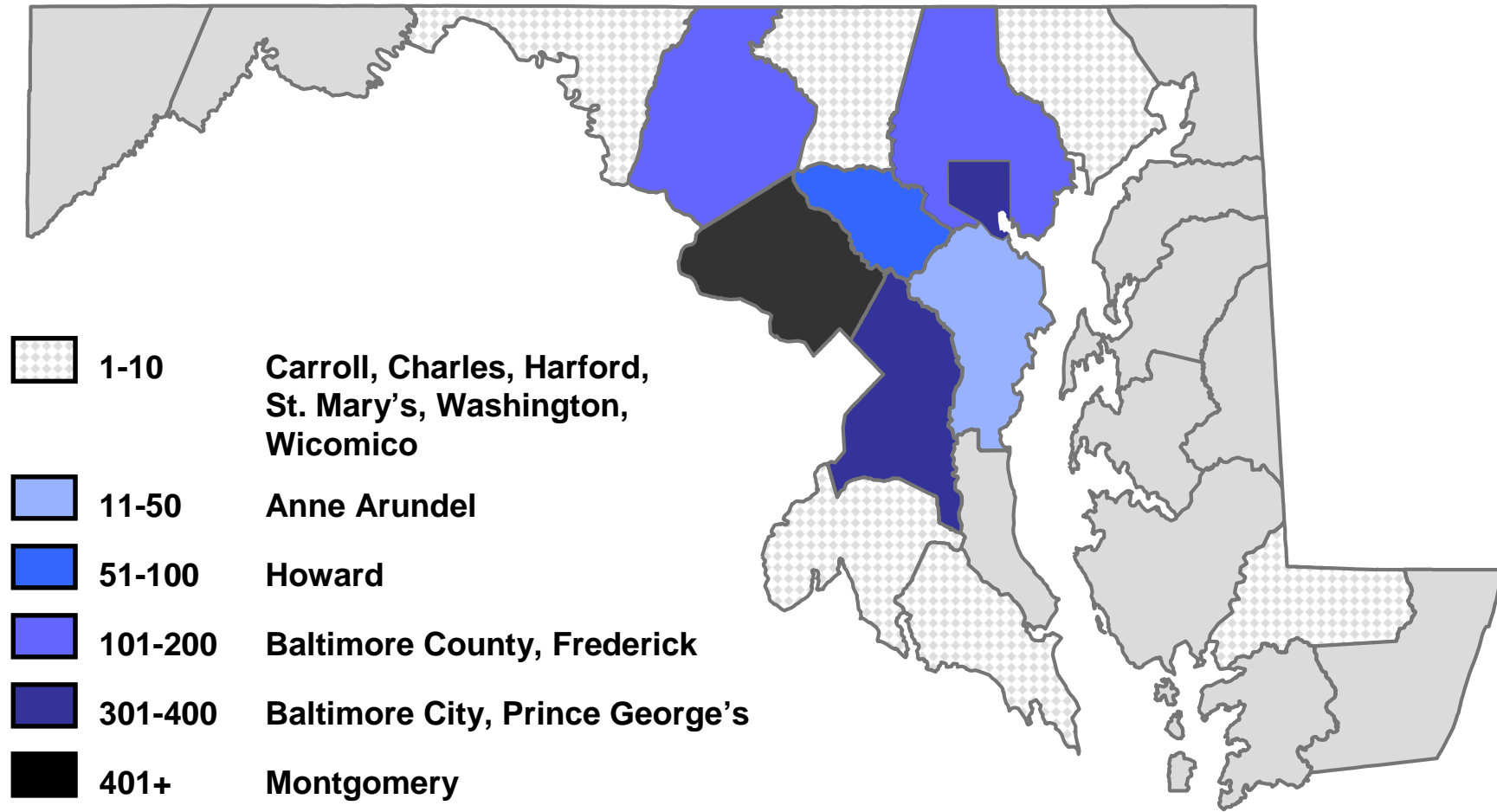

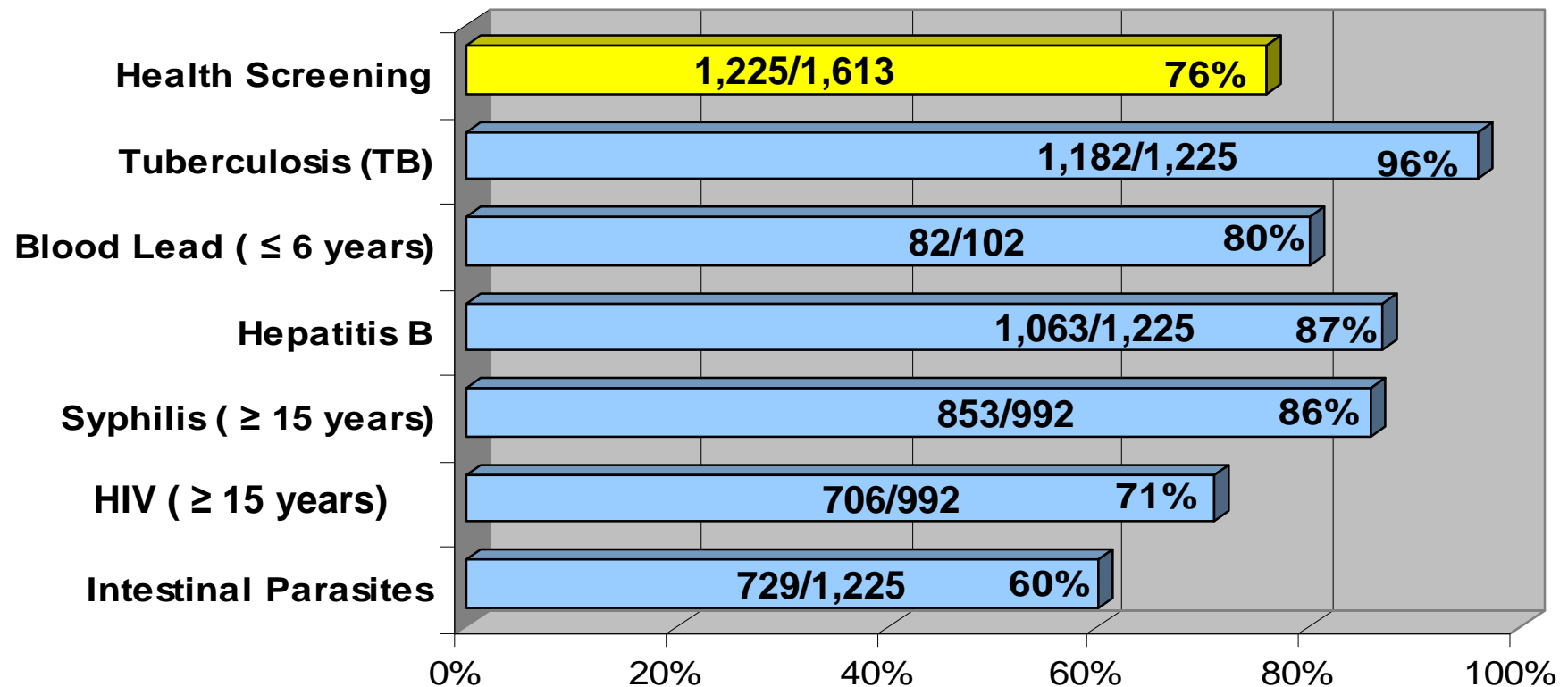
# Refugee/Asylee Arrivals by Initial Maryland County of Resettlement, 2008

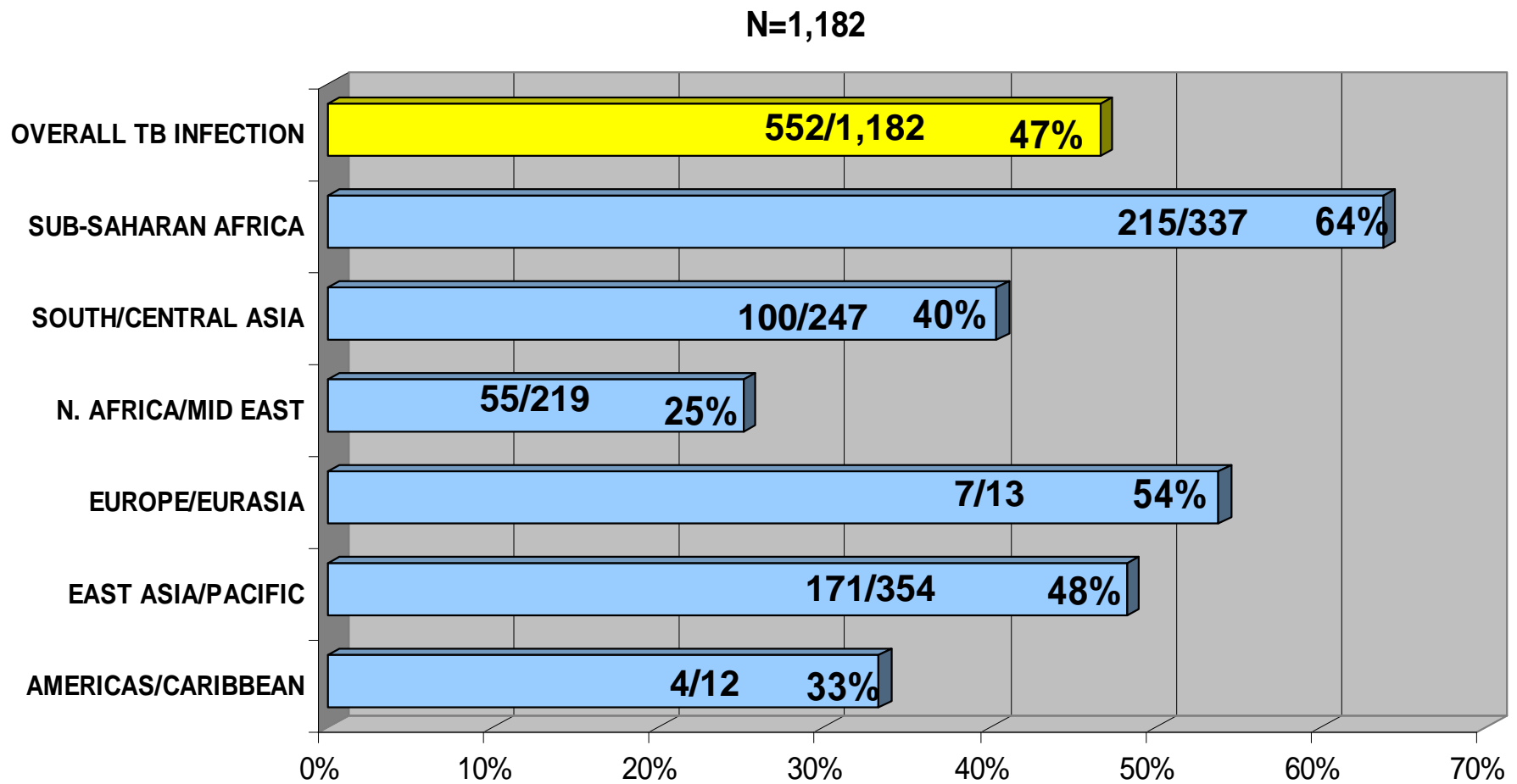

Tuberculosis Infection based on TST  $\geq$  10 mm

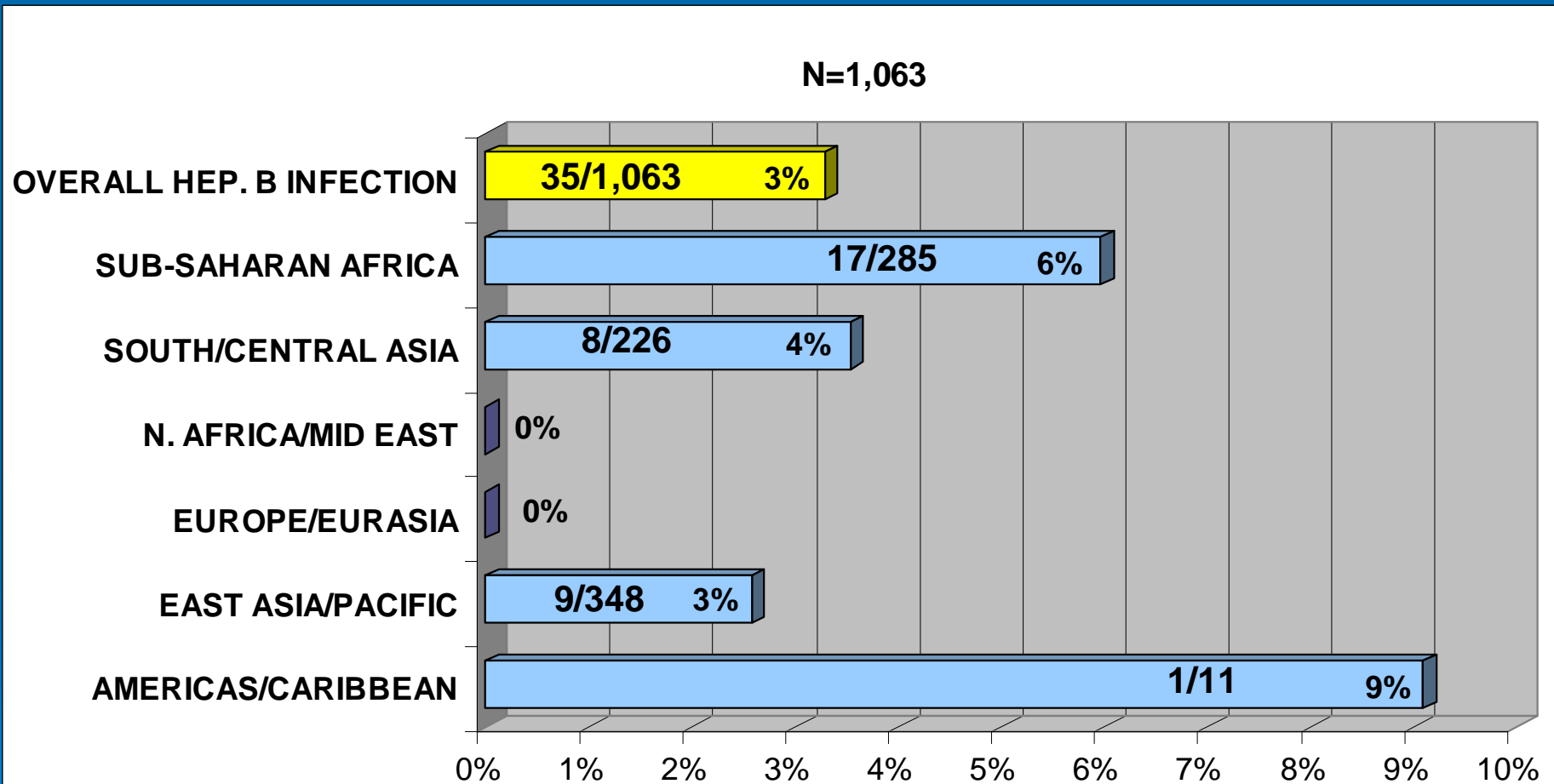

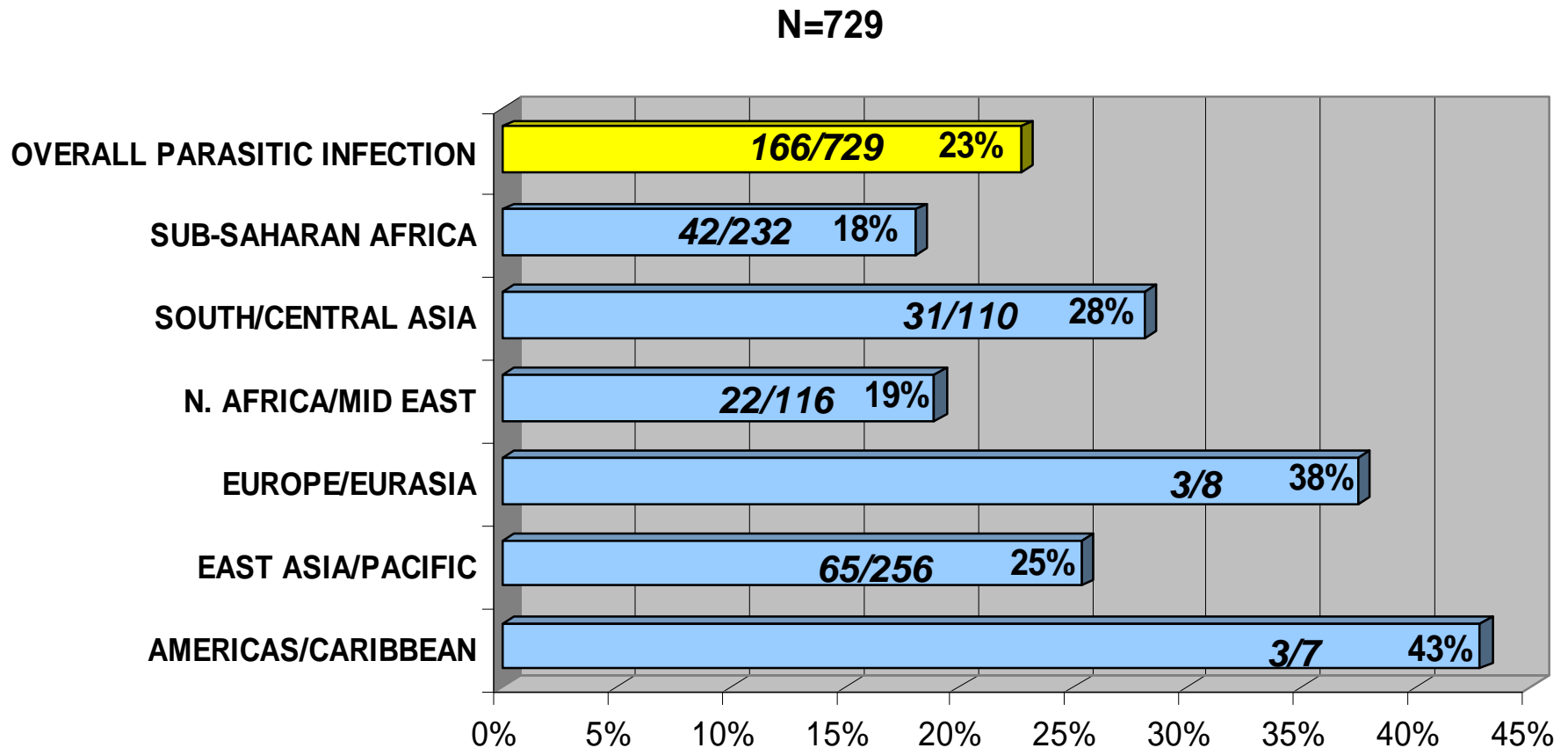
Hepatitis Infection based on HBsAg Positive

# Pathogenic Parasites among Refugees/Asylees in Maryland, 2008



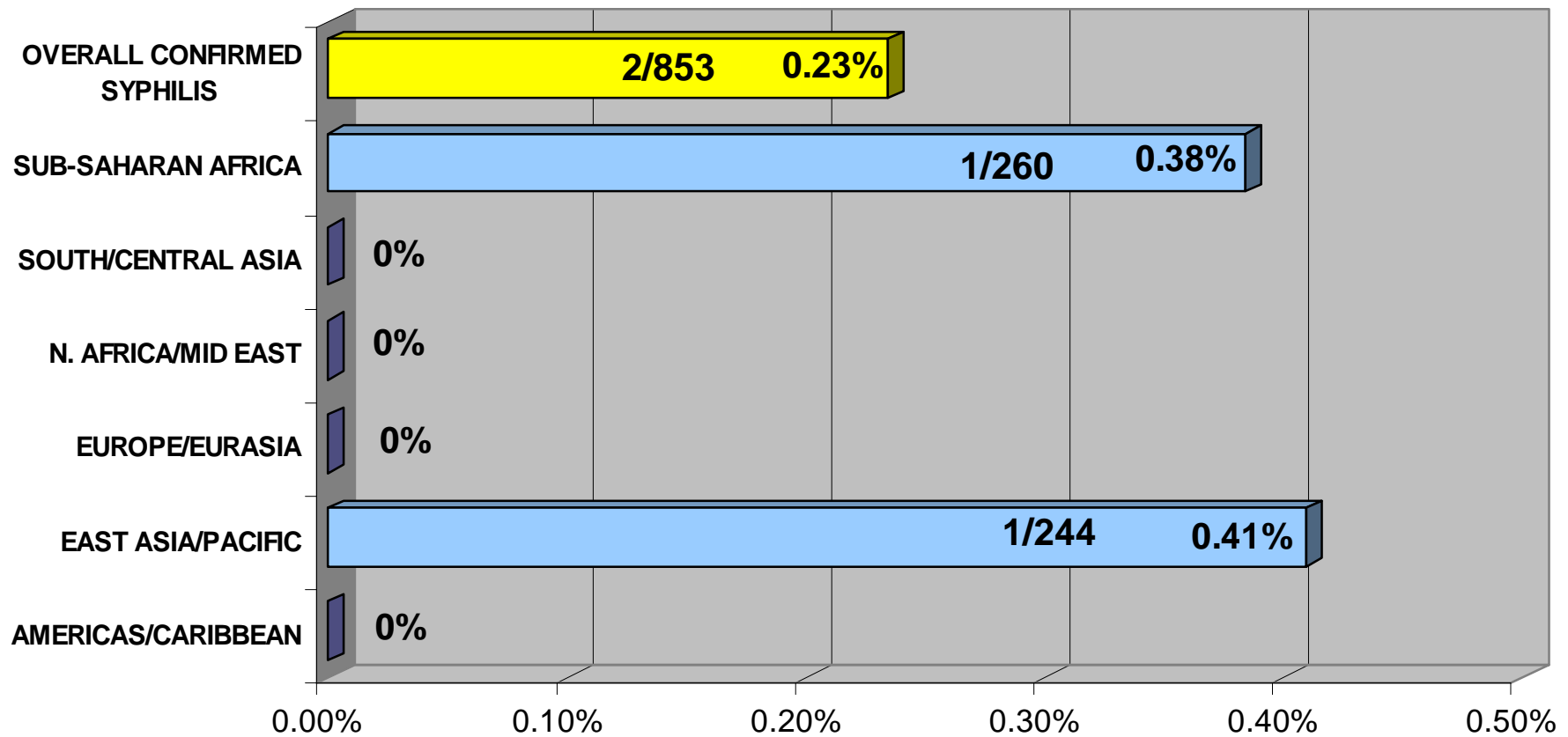
