



Mapping of County-Level Data






Project: Prepare Census Tract-Level Cancer Maps with Maryland Cancer Registry


➤ Created maps of cancer (all causes) for 2006 to 2014 by 5 year aggregations




Mapping of Census Tract-Level Data










2006 - 2010





2007 - 2011

Presenting Local Cancer Data

- ➤ When presenting local cancer data, some complex questions:
 - Which cancers should be presented?
 - Risk messaging/interpretation of data (maps, tables)
 - Significance testing/rate stability
 - Breakpoints (natural versus calculated)


