

Proclamation  
Oral Cancer Awareness Month  
April 2015

- Whereas: Oral Cancer Awareness Month is aimed at educating the public about the risk factors, signs and symptoms of the disease; and
- Whereas: When correct steps are taken, such as Maryland adults over 40 years of age receiving an annual oral cancer exam from their dental or medical provider; and
- Whereas: All Maryland residents quit the use of all tobacco products and limit alcoholic drinks; and
- Whereas: Use a lip balm with SPF of at least 15 anytime outdoors and consume a diet rich in fruits and vegetables; and
- Whereas: Vaccinate boys and girls beginning at age 11 or 12 against the Human Papillomavirus (HPV), the risk of Oral Cancer can be reduced; and
- Whereas: The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene Office of Oral Health supports the early detection of oral cancer and prevention of the disease through yearly oral cancer screenings and promoting tobacco cessation programs, such as, the Maryland Tobacco Quitline, 1-800-QUIT-NOW.
