# **CCHW Certificate Renewal**



### **CCHW Certification**

CHW certificates are effective for 2 years

 Certificates authorize the individual to represent themselves to the public as a certified community health worker (CCHW)



# **CCHW Certificate Renewal Application**

When can a CCHW begin their Certificate Renewal Application?

At any time!

Applications can be saved in draft mode in Maryland OneStop, updated at any time.

Maryland Certified Community Health Worker (CCHW) Certificate Expiration and Renewal Key Points

The following key points summarize Maryland's CCHW expiration and renewal process.

- · A CHW certificate is effective for two years from the date issued.
- . There is no fee for certification renewal.
- A CCHW should be prepared to submit their certificate renewal application 30 days prior to expiration.
- Renewal requirements include:
  - Submission of a community health worker certificate renewal application through the Maryland OneStop portal portal.
  - Documentation of 20 hours of a broad range of professional development activities.
  - A CCHW must notify the Department upon name or contact information change.

#### Things to know about certification renewal for CCHWs in Maryland:

- CCHWs may begin a Certificate Renewal Application at any time.
- CCHWs may submit their online Certificate Renewal Application with the required documentation 30 days prior to their certificate expiration date.
- The Certificate Renewal Application is open on Maryland OneStop so that CCHWs may enter
   information and upload Professional Development Activities Tracking Sheet/s)

- Read all website content
- Prepare all required materials

# **Key Points**

#### **CCHW Certificate Renewal**

- Voluntary
- Free of charge
- •Effective for two (2) years from the date of issuance
- Allow 30 days of processing time for a CCHW Certificate Renewal application



## Requirements

- Submit a complete application on Maryland OneStop
  - Paper application available upon request
- Documentation of 20 hours of a broad range of professional development activities
  - Check the associated CHW core competency or health principle
  - Include a brief description of knowledge learned or skills acquired



# **Professional Development**

The **broad range** of 20 hours of **professional development activities** include:

- Staff development or employer-sponsored training opportunities
- Conferences
- Webinars
- Online trainings
- Maryland Community Health Worker Association monthly meetings
- Community related meetings, committees, or workgroups that contain an educational component
- Other educational opportunities



# **Final Application Steps**

**Confirm** 20 hours of professional development activities are included in your application

- Check the associated CHW core competency
- Provide a brief summary of knowledge or skills
- Tip: Click on uploaded documents to be sure they open the way you intend

**Sign** and date the application **Submit** the application



## After the Application is Submitted

#### The CCHW will receive:

 Notice of additional information needed to complete their application

Or

 Notification the CCHW renewal application has been approved including a new certificate effective for two years



#### Applying for Reinstatement of an Expired Certificate

A CHW may apply for the reinstatement of a certificate up to two (2) years after the certificate expires.

#### Steps:

- Submit a CCHW Certificate Renewal Application
- Provide documentation of 20 hours of professional development within 2 years preceding renewal date



# Certificate Renewal for Certified CHWs

### **Notification of CCHW Certificate Renewal**



#### **Notification of CCHW Certificate Renewal**

The Department will send CCHWs a renewal notice about 90 days before their certificate expires

Notice will be sent to the last known electronic address

#### Notice will include:

The date on which the current certificate expires



# **CCHW Certificate Renewal - timeline**

CCHWs should notify our office if a renewal notice is not received within 60 days before the renewal date

## Submit CCHW certificate renewal application on Maryland OneStop

 Allow 30 days for an application to be processed and a new certificate to be issued
