### **Opening Remarks**

Frances B. Phillips, Chair, presented opening remarks to update the group on the state of coronavirus in the U.S. and Maryland. Cheryl DePinto responded to a question about the 2020 Maryland legislative session, confirming that none of the legislation under consideration for this session relates directly to community health workers.

### **CHW Certification Program Implementation**

Advisory committee staff, Kim Hiner, provided an update on the CHW certification program implementation.

### **Proposed Regulations Update**

COMAR 10.68.01 and 10.68.02 went into effect on December 30, 2019.

# **Certification Update**

As of February 10, 2020, MDH has issued a total of 230 community health worker certifications. The community health worker certification team has increased there outreach this past month and have seen a corresponding increase in applications. The official application deadline for experience based CHW certification is March 31, 2020.

A 60-day extension beyond that deadline will be announced for any applicants who may be encountering challenges with receiving their letters of validations in a timely manner. However, the program is holding off on announcing that extension for now, to encourage as many CHWs as possible to apply by the official deadline. Kim reminded that the MDH CHW team continues to be available for technical assistance with CCHW applications.

Kim requested assistance from the Advisory Committee for recommendations for additional outreach avenues. Lilian Amaya suggested Latino Provider Network monthly meetings and the Governor's Office of Multicultural Affairs. Rosario Campos suggested Frederick Memorial. Kim also requested suggestions for content to be included in newsletters and other outreach, as well as to communicate to MDH CHW team any barriers that have arisen during the application process.

The CCHW application process based on completion of an accredited training program will open April 1, 2020.

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### **CHW Certification Training Program Accreditation Process**

#### **Proposed Regulations Update**

Advisory committee staff, Kim Hiner, provided an update on the CHW certification training program accreditation process. The training program accreditation application process under COMAR 10.68.02.03 launched on January 1, 2020.

### **Outreach and education**

CHW team has reached out to known training entities to inform them of the accreditation opportunity and application process. Team offered a technical assistance webinar on January 13, 2020 which was well-attended (40 registrants). Another technical assistance webinar will be offered February 19, 2020 at 3pm. One-on-one assistance is also available from MDH CHW team.

As of 2/10/2020, 1 application has been submitted to MDH and 6 draft applications are inprocess.

# **Application Review Committee**

Applications for CHW and Health Professions Educator seats are being accepted through February 24, 2020. in-person review committee orientation will be held Monday March 16. 2020 at 12pm-4pm. For the state CHW advisory committee seat, members don't need to apply online, simply submit statement of interest to Kim Hiner via email.
