

## **CHW Certification Program Update**



### **Certification Application – Deadline Suspension**

#### Related to COVID-19

- Sec. Neall suspended the March 31 deadline for CHWs to submit applications for certification based on experience
- Deadline suspension effective until 30 days after the state of emergency has been terminated



## **Certification Update – Experienced CHWs**

Certification for Experienced CHWs - September 1, 2019 – May 14, 2020

# applications submitted to MHD:	633
# submitted applications in review process (under review and applicant receiving assistance with completion):	60
# total certificates issued by MDH:	573

 CHWs who are not certified under this process will be required to complete a CHW certification training program accredited by the Department to be eligible for certification

  - Including outreach to certified CHWs (CCHWs)





#### Maryland CCHW Renewal

\* More information, including a CCHW renewal manual, will be released soon. CCHWs will be emailed once all renewal information has been posted.

#### Maryland CCHW Certificate Expiration and Renewal Key Points

The following key points summarize Maryland's CCHW expiration and renewal process.

- . A CHW certificate is effective for two years from the date issued.
- . There is no fee for certification renewal.
- · A CCHW should be prepared to submit their renewal application 30 days prior to expiration.
- · Renewal requirements include:
  - Submission of a renewal application through the Maryland OneStop portal.
  - Documentation of 20 hours of a broad range of professional development activities.
  - A CCHW must notify the Department upon name or contact information change.



#### **CHW Certification Renewal Process**

- CHW certificates are effective for 2 years from the date issued
- The Department to send the CHW a renewal notice 90 days before the certificate expires
- Renewal applications shall be received 30 calendar days prior to the expiration date



#### **CHW Certification Renewal Process**

#### Requirements:

- Renewal application via Maryland OneStop
- Documentation of completion of 20 hours of a broad range of professional development activities

#### Community Health Worker Certification Training Program Accreditation

The accreditation process for Community Health Worker (CHW) Certification Training Programs is now open!

The Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 10.68.02.02 (Community Health Worker Certification Training Programs) requires all CHW certification training programs to be accredited by the Maryland Department of Health (the Department) and that an accreditation shall be issued before an organization may offer a CHW certification training program. To obtain accreditation of a CHW certification training program, an organization must submit an accreditation application to the Department.

#### **CHW CertificationTraining Program Requirements**

**COMAR 10.68.02.03** - Training Program Requirements

A CHW certification training program shall:

- Provide a minimum of 100 hours of instruction
- Verify successful completion of an additional supervised 40-hour practicum by a student
- Employ a curriculum framework that incorporates, at a minimum, the Maryland CHW nine core competencies
- Include an objective knowledge assessment



#### **CHW Certification Training Program Accreditation Application**

#### **Accreditation Application Due Dates**

- December 31, 2020
  - Training programs who trained individuals from Oct. 1, 2018 Dec. 31, 2020 requesting retroactive accreditation to October 1, 2018
- No deadline for:
  - Programs not requesting retroactive accreditation
  - New programs

#### **COMAR 10.68.02.04B** – Application Review Committee

Training program applications will be reviewed by a CHW Training Program Application Review Committee consisting of:

- A community health worker;
- A State Community Health Worker Advisory Committee member;
- A health professions educator with expertise in curriculum development;
- An MDH CHW certification program staff member; and
- As deemed necessary by the Department, an MDH program staff member to be determined based on expertise needed

## Certification Based on Completion of an Accredited CHW Certification Training Program

Effective April 1, 2020 applications are accepted for certification based on the completion of an accredited CHW training program

#### Requirements:

- Documentation of successful completion of CHW certification training program accredited by the Department
- Minimum age of 18 years
- High School Diploma or GED equivalent
