CHW Legislative Overview and Background

2014 - House Bill 856/Senate Bill 592 - *Workgroup on Workforce Development for Community Health Workers*

- Workgroup was asked to make recommendations on training, credentialing, reimbursement and payment policies.
- Report submitted to Maryland General Assembly by the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) and Maryland Insurance Administration in June 2015

2016 - MDH CHW Advisory Committee

- Organized by the Office of Minority Health and Health Disparities
- Focus on providing an opportunity for more CHWs to participate

2017 - HB1113 / SB988 - Health Occupations – Maryland Community Health Worker Act

• Did not pass

2017 Community Health Workers Workgroup meeting

- Organized by Senator Shirley Nathan-Pulliam and Delegate Clarence Lam
- Discussed concerns with previous bills, areas of consensus and areas of further consideration



CHW Legislative Overview and Background

- 2018 House Bill 0490 / Senate Bill 0163 (Chapter 441) Public Health – Community Health Workers – Advisory Committee and Certification
 - The Act took effect on October 1, 2018



House Bill 0490 / Senate Bill 0163 (Chapter 441)

Statutory Mandate and Timeline

Primary mandates:

- The establishment, operation and functioning of the State Community Health Worker Advisory Committee
- The setup and implementation of a certification and training process for CHWs in the state
- The establishment of the State Community Health Workers Fund



House Bill 0490 / Senate Bill 0163 (Chapter 441)

Statutory Mandate and Timeline

The Advisory Committee is to meet at regular intervals to provide recommendation on the:

- Process of certification and training of CHW these includes:
 - Accreditation of training programs for CHWs
 - Certification of apprenticeship programs



House Bill 0490 / Senate Bill 0163 (Chapter 441)

Statutory Mandate and Timeline

Areas of focus for recommendation include:

- Training and tiers of training
- Fees for certification
- Grandfathering
- Disciplinary and monitoring systems
- The appropriate term of a certificate and renewal procedures



Statutory Mandate and Timeline

Over the next year, establish:

- Certification criteria, standards and tiers
- Accreditation criteria, standards and processes for training institutions of CHW
- Facilitating the set up of a database by MDH
- Facilitating the setup of the CHW fund
