90791	Psychiatric diagnostic evaluation without medical services
90792	Psychiatric diagnostic evaluation with medical services
H0001	Alcohol and/or drug assessment - Medicaid
Psychotherapy - Individual Session	
90832	Psychotherapy, <b>16-37 minutes</b> with patient only
90834	Psychotherapy, <b>38-52 minutes</b> with patient only
90837	Psychotherapy, <b>53-60 minutes</b> with patient only
90889	<b>IOP Counseling 2 hrs.</b> Preparation of report of patient's psychiatric status, history, treatment, or progress (other than for legal or consultative purposes) for other individuals, agencies, or insurance carriers
H0004	Behavioral health counseling and therapy, <b>per 15 minutes</b> - Medicaid <b>15 min.    30 min.    45 min.    60 min.    75 min.    90 min.</b>
H0015	<b>IOP Counseling 2 Hrs. (MA)</b> Alcohol and/or drug services; intensive outpatient (treatment program that operates at least 3 hours/day and at least 3 days/week and is based on an individualized treatment plan), including assessment, counseling; crisis intervention, and activity therapies or education - Medicaid
Psychotherapy - Group Session	
90853	<b>Group psychotherapy</b> , typically 45-60minutes (other than of a multiple-family group)
90849	<b>Multiple-family group psychotherapy</b>
90889	<b>IOP Counseling 2 hrs.</b> Preparation of report of patient's psychiatric status, history, treatment, or progress (other than for legal or consultative purposes) for other individuals, agencies, or insurance carriers.
H0005	<b>Group Counseling (MA)</b> Alcohol and/or drug services; group counseling by a clinician - Medicaid
H0015	<b>IOP Counseling 2 Hrs. (MA)</b> Alcohol and/or drug services; intensive outpatient (treatment program that operates at least 3 hours/day and at least 3 days/week and is based on an individualized treatment plan), including assessment, counseling; crisis intervention, and activity therapies or education - Medicaid
Drug Testing (Medicare only)	
G0431	<b>LAB Drug Test:</b> Drug screen, qualitative; multiple drug classes by high complexity test method (e.g., immunoassay, enzyme assay), per patient encounter
G0434	<b>Instant Drug Test:</b> Drug screen, other than chromatographic; any number of drug classes, by CLIA waived test or moderate complexity test, per patient encounter

<b>Evaluation and Management – New Patient</b> ( <u>not seen</u> at LHD in 3 years)	
99202	<b>New patient E/M</b> , which requires these 3 key components: An expanded problem focused history; An expanded problem focused exam; Straightforward medical decision making. Counseling and/or coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are of low to moderate severity. <b>Typically, 20 minutes are spent face-to-face with the patient and/or family.</b>
99203	<b>New patient E/M</b> , which requires these 3 key components: A detailed history; A detailed exam; Medical decision making of low complexity. Counseling and/or coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are of moderate severity. <b>Typically, 30 minutes are spent face-to-face with the patient and/or family.</b>
99204	<b>New patient E/M</b> , which requires these 3 key components: A comprehensive history; A comprehensive exam; Medical decision making of moderate complexity. Counseling and/or coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are of moderate to high severity. <b>Typically, 45 minutes are spent face-to-face with the patient and/or family.</b>
99205	<b>New patient E/M</b> , which requires these 3 key components: A comprehensive history; A comprehensive exam; Medical decision making of high complexity. Counseling and/or coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are of moderate to high severity. <b>Typically, 60 minutes are spent face-to-face with the patient and/or family.</b>
<b>Evaluation and Management – Established Patient</b> ( <u>has</u> been seen at LHD within the past 3 years)	
99211	<b>Established patient E/M</b> , which may not require the presence of a physician or other qualified health care professional. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are minimal. <b>Typically, 5 minutes are spent performing or supervising these services.</b>
99212	<b>Established patient E/M</b> , which requires at least 2 of these 3 key components: A problem focused history; A problem focused exam; Straightforward medical decision making. Counseling and/or coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are self-limited or minor. <b>Typically, 10 minutes are spent face-to-face with the patient and/or family.</b>

Evaluation and Management – Established Patient - continued (has been seen at LHD within the past 3 years)	
99213	<b>Established patient E/M</b> , which requires at least 2 of these 3 key components: An expanded problem focused history; An expanded problem focused exam; Medical decision making of low complexity. Counseling and coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are of low to moderate severity. <b>Typically, 15 minutes are spent face-to-face with the patient and/or family.</b>
99214	<b>Established patient E/M</b> , which requires at least 2 of 3 key components: A detailed history; A detailed exam; Medical decision making of moderate complexity. Counseling and/or coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are of moderate to high severity. <b>Typically, 25 minutes are spent face-to-face with the patient and/or family.</b>
99215	<b>Established patient E/M</b> , which requires at least 2 of these 3 key components: A comprehensive history; A comprehensive exam; Medical decision making of high complexity. Counseling and/or coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are of moderate to high severity. <b>Typically, 40 minutes are spent face-to-face with the patient and/or family.</b>
Psychotherapy with Evaluation and Management Visit	
90833	<b>Psychotherapy, 16-37 minutes</b> with patient only, when performed with an evaluation and management service (List separately in addition to the code for primary procedure 99201-99205, 99212-99215)
90836	<b>Psychotherapy, 38-52 minutes</b> with patient and/or family member when performed with an evaluation and management service (List separately in addition to the code for primary procedure 99201-99205, 99212-99215)
90838	<b>Psychotherapy, 53-60 minutes</b> with patient and/or family member when performed with an evaluation and management service (List separately in addition to the code for primary procedure 99201-99205, 99212-99215)
Injections	
96372	Therapeutic, prophylactic, or diagnostic injection (specify substance or drug); SQ or IM
J2315	Vivitrol medication 380 mg. Injection, naltrexone, depot form, 1 mg
