- Extra warm clothes (boots, hat and gloves)
- □ First aid kit

TRAFFIC DELAYS

If you are stuck in a traffic jam or your car becomes disabled...

- Stay with the vehicle
- Run your engine and heater for short intervals
- Crack a window in the vehicle to avoid carbon monoxide build-up
- Listen to your radio for updated traffic and emergency information
- Drink fluids to avoid dehydration
